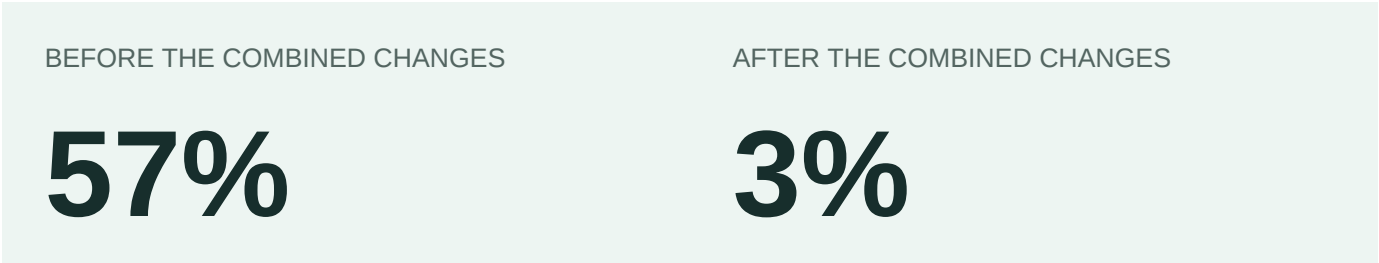


Reducing invented sell rules

A controlled pre-launch finding from DX Terminal Pro

Sell traces sometimes cited rules the owner had never supplied. The paper reports the following change after a combined revision to prompt wording and the treatment of previous decisions.



Share of sell decisions containing fabricated rules, as reported in Table 4.

WHAT CHANGED

The harness removed law-like wording, treated prior decisions as context rather than precedent, and prohibited invented thresholds and named rules. The reported result belongs to that combined intervention.

WHAT THE NUMBERS ESTABLISH

The comparison concerns affected pre-launch test populations. It measures rule-fabrication incidence. It does not isolate a memory-label change, measure investment returns, or establish the result on another model or venue.

Exact per-arm decision counts are not reported in Table 4 or its adjacent account. The paper describes 4,900 classified traces across aggregate diagnosis; that total is not the stated denominator for each side of this comparison.
